A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to amend section 79-265.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2023; to provide an additional exception to the prohibition on suspending a student in pre kindergarten through second grade; and to repeal the original section.

6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 79-265.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2023, is
 amended to read:

3 79-265.01 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, 4 an elementary school shall not suspend a student in pre-kindergarten 5 through second grade. Each school district shall develop a policy to 6 implement this section which shall include disciplinary measures inside 7 the school as an alternative to suspension.

8 (2) An elementary school may suspend a student in pre-kindergarten
9 through second grade if such student:

<u>(a) Brings brings</u> a deadly weapon as defined in section 28-109 <u>onto</u>
 on school grounds, <u>into</u> <u>in</u> a vehicle owned, leased, or contracted by a
 school being used for a school purpose or <u>into</u> <u>in</u> a vehicle being driven
 for a school purpose by a school employee or his or her designee, or <u>to</u>
 at a school-sponsored activity or athletic event; or <u>-</u>

(b) Engages in violent behavior capable of causing physical harm to
 another student or a school employee.

Sec. 2. Original section 79-265.01, Revised Statutes Supplement,2023, is repealed.
