#### Committee:

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Motor Vehicle Registration Act; to
- 2 amend section 60-3,191, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
- 3 change the registration fee for alternative fuel-powered motor
- 4 vehicles; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 60-3,191, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
- 2 is amended to read:
- 3 60-3,191 In addition to any other fee required under the Motor
- 4 Vehicle Registration Act, a fee for registration of each motor vehicle
- 5 powered by an alternative fuel shall be charged. The fee shall be
- 6 seventy-five dollars for each such motor vehicle registered in 2022,
- 7 ninety-three dollars for each such motor vehicle registered in 2023, one
- 8 hundred eleven dollars for each such motor vehicle registered in 2024,
- 9 one hundred thirty dollars for each such motor vehicle registered in
- 10 2025, one hundred forty-five dollars for each such motor vehicle
- 11 <u>registered in 2026, and one hundred fifty dollars for each such motor</u>
- 12 vehicle registered in 2027 and every year thereafter. The fee shall be
- 13 collected by the county treasurer and remitted to the State Treasurer for
- 14 credit to the Highway Trust Fund.
- 15 Sec. 2. Original section 60-3,191, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 16 Nebraska, is repealed.
