A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend section 28-101, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2019; to create the offense of sexual exploitation of a student; to define terms; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original section.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 28-101, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2019, is amended to read:

28-101 Sections 28-101 to 28-1357 and 28-1601 to 28-1603 and section $\underline{2}$ of this act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Criminal Code.

Sec. 2. (1) A school official commits the offense of sexual exploitation of a student if such school official engages in sexual penetration or sexual contact with a student prior to one year following such school student:
(a) Graduating from school; or
(b) Otherwise ceasing to be enrolled in school.
(2) A violation of this section is a Class II felony.
(3) It is not a defense to a charge under this section that the school student consented to the sexual penetration or sexual contact.
(4) For purposes of this section:
(a) School means a school under the jurisdiction of a school board authorized by Chapter 79 or under the governing authority of a private, denominational, or parochial school;
(b)(i) School official means an individual who is nineteen years of age or older and who is a teacher, school official, school administrator, coach, school employee, or a volunteer acting as a teacher or coach or as an assistant to a teacher or coach;
(ii) School official does not include a school student assisting a school official;
(c) Sexual contact has the same meaning as in section 28-318; and
(d) Sexual penetration has the same meaning as in section 28-318.

Sec. 3. Original section 28-101, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2019, is repealed.
