1 Section 1. Section 28-101, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2023, is

- 3 28-101 Sections 28-101 to 28-1357, 28-1601 to 28-1603, and 28-1701
- 4 and section 2 of this act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska
- 5 Criminal Code.
- 6 Sec. 2. (1) For purposes of this section, camping means temporary
- 7 lodging out of doors and presupposes the occupancy of a shelter designed
- 8 or used for such purposes such as a sleeping bag or tent or other
- 9 structure.
- 10 (2) It shall be unlawful to knowingly camp on property owned or
- 11 controlled by a political subdivision not designated as a campsite by the
- 12 <u>political subdivision when notice that the property has not been</u>
- 13 <u>designated as a campsite has been provided by:</u>
- 14 (a) Actual communication to the person; or
- 15 (b) Posting in a manner prescribed by law or reasonably likely to
- 16 come to the attention of persons attempting to camp on such property.
- 17 (3) A violation of this section is a Class III misdemeanor, and a
- 18 person who violates this section may be ordered to pay any amount as
- 19 determined by the court which may be necessary to reimburse the political
- 20 <u>subdivision</u> for the expense of repairing any damage to such property
- 21 <u>resulting from such violation.</u>
