- 4 <u>and section 2 of this act</u> shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska
- 5 Criminal Code.
- 6 Sec. 2. (1) A person shall not intentionally and without authority:
- 7 (a) Remove, destroy, alter, tamper with, damage, or circumvent the
- 8 operation of an electronic monitoring device required to be worn or used
- 9 by that person or another person pursuant to a court order or as a
- 10 condition of parole; or
- 11 (b) Request, authorize, or solicit a person to remove, destroy,
- 12 <u>alter, tamper with, damage, or circumvent the operation of an electronic</u>
- 13 monitoring device required to be worn or used by that person or another
- 14 person pursuant to a court order or as a condition of parole.
- 15 (2) A violation of this section is a Class IV felony.
- 16 (3) For purposes of this section, electronic monitoring device means
- 17 a device used to track the location of a person.
