- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) On and after the effective date of this act, each
- 2 <u>school board shall prominently display the national motto of the United</u>
- 3 States, "In God We Trust", written legibly in English, in each classroom
- 4 or in another prominent place in each school building where each student
- 5 <u>is able to see and read it each day school is in session.</u>
- 6 (2) A school board may accept contributions to defray the costs of
- 7 <u>implementing this section.</u>
- 8 (3) Upon the filing of an action seeking to invalidate this section
- 9 <u>in any state or federal court, the Attorney General shall intervene on</u>
- 10 <u>behalf of any school board and any other party named as a defendant for</u>
- 11 <u>their role in implementing this section.</u>
