1 Section 1. Section 38-2801, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2022, is amended to read:
- 3 38-2801 Sections 38-2801 to 38-28,107 <u>and section 2 of this act</u> and
- 4 the Nebraska Drug Product Selection Act shall be known and may be cited
- 5 as the Pharmacy Practice Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. If a practitioner is no longer in practice for any reason,
- 7 including death, extended illness, retirement, relocation, or suspension
- 8 or revocation of the credential by the appropriate board, a pharmacist
- 9 may use professional judgment to (1) continue to refill a prescription
- 10 issued by such a practitioner that has previously authorized refills, (2)
- 11 continue to fill a prescription issued by such a practitioner for a
- 12 <u>controlled substance listed in Schedule II, III, IV, or V of section</u>
- 13 28-405 with a delayed fill date noted at the time of prescribing, or (3)
- 14 provide a one-time emergency refill of a prescription issued by such a
- 15 practitioner for up to a ninety-day supply of maintenance medications,
- 16 <u>including controlled substances listed in Schedule III, IV, or V of</u>
- 17 section 28-405.
- 18 Sec. 3. Original section 38-2801, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 19 Supplement, 2022, is repealed.
