1 Section 1. Section 79-8,145, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2022, is amended to read:
- 79-8,145 (1) In addition to certificates issued pursuant to sections 3
- 4 79-806 to 79-815:
- (a) The Commissioner of Education shall, subject to the provisions 5
- of subsection (3) of this section, grant a temporary certificate to teach 6
- 7 on a full-time basis to any applicant who:
- (i) Has completed a teacher education program at a standard 8
- 9 institution of higher education as defined in section 79-807; and
- 10 (ii) Currently possesses a certificate to teach in good standing
- from another state; and 11
- (b) The Commissioner of Education commissioner may, subject to the 12
- 13 provisions of subsection (3) of this section, grant a temporary
- certificate to teach on a full-time basis to any applicant who: 14
- (i) Has earned and been awarded a bachelor's degree, graduate 15
- degree, or professional degree from a college or university accredited by 16
- 17 an accrediting organization recognized by the United States Department of
- Education; and 18
- (ii) Has satisfactorily demonstrated basic skills competency and 19
- passed any appropriate subject area examination as designated by the 20
- State Board of Education; and -21
- 22 (c)(i) The Commissioner of Education shall, subject to the
- provisions of subsection (3) of this section, grant a temporary 23
- 24 certificate to teach on a full-time basis to any applicant who:
- 25 (A) Is a veteran with at least forty-eight months of military
- 26 <u>service;</u>
- (B) Has a minimum of sixty college credits with a minimum cumulative 27
- grade point average of 2.5 on a four-point scale or the equivalent; and 28
- 29 (C) Has passed any appropriate subject area examination as
- designated by the State Board of Education. 30
- (ii) An applicant issued a temporary certificate to teach pursuant 31

- 1 to subdivision (1)(c)(i) of this section shall be assigned a teacher
- 2 <u>mentor for a minimum of two school years after commencing employment.</u>
- 3 <u>Each teacher mentor shall be selected by the principal or other</u>
- 4 appropriate school administrator and shall:
- 5 (A) Hold a valid certificate to teach in Nebraska; and
- 6 (B) Have at least three years of teaching experience.
- 7 (2)(a) (2) Any temporary certificate to teach issued pursuant to
- 8 subdivisions (1)(a) and (b) of this section shall be valid for a period
- 9 not to exceed two years, during which the holder of such temporary
- 10 certificate must obtain a certificate to teach pursuant to sections
- 11 79-806 to 79-815 by completing the requirements contained in such
- 12 sections.
- 13 <u>(b) Any temporary certificate to teach issued pursuant to</u>
- 14 <u>subdivision (1)(c)(i) of this section is not renewable and shall be valid</u>
- 15 for a period not to exceed five years, during which the holder of such
- 16 temporary certificate must obtain a certificate to teach pursuant to
- 17 sections 79-806 to 79-815 by completing the requirements contained in
- 18 such sections.
- 19 (3) Issuance of a temporary certificate to teach pursuant to this
- 20 section shall be subject to a criminal history record information check
- 21 pursuant to section 79-814.01 and payment of any required fees.
- 22 (4) For purposes of this section, veteran means a person who served
- 23 on active or reserve duty in the armed forces of the United States or in
- 24 the National Guard, and who was discharged or released from service under
- 25 conditions other than dishonorable.
