- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Motor Vehicle Operator's License Act;
- 2 to amend section 60-474, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and
- 3 sections 60-462 and 60-463, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 4 2022; to provide for a driving privilege card to federally
- 5 authorized aliens; to define and redefine terms; to harmonize
- 6 provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 2 2022, is amended to read:
- 3 60-462 Sections 60-462 to 60-4,189 and sections 4 to 8 of this act
- 4 shall be known and may be cited as the Motor Vehicle Operator's License

- 6 Sec. 2. Section 60-463, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 7 2022, is amended to read:
- 8 60-463 For purposes of the Motor Vehicle Operator's License Act, the
- 9 definitions found in sections 60-463.01 to 60-478 and sections 4 and 5 of
- 10 this act shall be used.
- 11 Sec. 3. Section 60-474, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 12 amended to read:
- 13 60-474 Operator's or driver's license shall mean any license or
- 14 permit to operate a motor vehicle issued under the laws of this state,
- 15 including:
- 16 (1) Any replacement license or instruction permit;
- 17 (2) The privilege of any person to drive a motor vehicle whether
- 18 such person holds a valid license;
- 19 (3) Any nonresident's operating privilege which shall mean the
- 20 privilege conferred upon a nonresident by the laws of this state
- 21 pertaining to the operation of a motor vehicle in this state by such
- 22 person or the use in this state of a vehicle owned by such person;
- 23 (4) An employment driving permit issued as provided by sections
- 24 60-4,129 and 60-4,130; and
- 25 (5) A medical hardship driving permit issued as provided by sections
- 26 60-4,130.01 and 60-4,130.02; and -
- 27 (6) A driving privilege card issued pursuant to sections 6 to 8 of
- 28 this act.
- 29 Sec. 4. <u>Driving privilege card means a license to operate a motor</u>
- 30 vehicle created pursuant to section 202(d)(11) of the federal REAL ID Act
- 31 of 2005, Public Law 109-13, as such section existed on January 1, 2023,

1 issued to a federally authorized alien whose presence in the United

- 2 States is not specified in section 202(c)(2)(B)(i) through (x) of the
- 3 federal REAL ID Act of 2005, as such section existed on January 1, 2023.
- 4 The driving privilege card may be classified as follows:
- 5 (1) Class O license;
- 6 (2) Class M license;
- 7 (3) POP-provisional operator's permit;
- 8 (4) LPD-learner's permit; and
- 9 (5) Any other classification authorized by the director.
- 10 Sec. 5. Federally authorized alien means an alien who is present in
- 11 <u>the United States with the approval of the United States Government. The</u>
- 12 term includes aliens currently classified in categories of parole,
- including parole granted pursuant to 8 U.S.C. 1182(d)(5), as such section
- 14 existed on January 1, 2023; aliens with a valid employment authorization
- document; and any other similarly situated aliens.
- Sec. 6. (1) Each driving privilege card shall be similar in design
- 17 <u>to other Nebraska operator's licenses, but include a unique design and</u>
- 18 <u>color indicator.</u>
- 19 <u>(2) The face of each driving privilege card shall include the</u>
- 20 <u>phrases:</u>
- 21 (a) "Not Valid for Official Federal Purposes."; and
- 22 (b) "Not Valid Photographic Identification for Voting.".
- 23 Sec. 7. (1) A driving privilege card confers upon the recipient the
- 24 privilege to operate a motor vehicle pursuant to the classification
- 25 specified on the driving privilege card.
- 26 (2) A driving privilege card issued under this section shall be
- 27 valid identification for any lawful purpose other than for official
- 28 federal purposes or for purposes of voting.
- 29 <u>(3) It is a violation of Nebraska law to discriminate against a</u>
- 30 person because such person holds or presents a driving privilege card.
- 31 (4) A driving privilege card shall not be held concurrently with

- 1 another Nebraska operator's license.
- 2 (5) Any provision that applies to a Nebraska operator's license or a
- 3 specific class of operator's license also applies to the driving
- 4 privilege card and the specific class specified on the driving privilege
- 5 card.
- 6 (6) A driving privilege card shall expire in the same manner as an
- 7 operator's license pursuant to section 60-484.05.
- 8 Sec. 8. (1)(a) A person who is a federally authorized alien is
- 9 <u>eligible for a driving privilege card if such person can establish proof:</u>
- (i) That such person is a federally authorized alien;
- 11 (ii) Of such person's identity;
- 12 (iii) That such person is a Nebraska resident; and
- 13 <u>(iv) That such person is otherwise qualified for an operator's</u>
- 14 permit.
- 15 (b) A person who is a federally authorized alien shall not be
- 16 <u>ineligible for a driving privilege card solely because such person cannot</u>
- 17 satisfy the requirements specified in section 60-484.04 or does not
- 18 possess a social security number.
- 19 (2) A person who is a federally authorized alien shall establish
- 20 <u>such authorization by providing documentation issued by the United States</u>
- 21 Citizenship and Immigration Services demonstrating that such person is
- 22 present in the United States with the permission of the United States
- 23 Government. Such documentation may be verified electronically through the
- 24 Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements program.
- 25 (3) A person who is a federally authorized alien shall prove such
- 26 person's identity as required by this section by complying with
- 27 <u>subsection (6) of section 60-484 or by providing one of the following</u>
- 28 documents that contains such person's full legal name and date of birth:
- 29 (a) A consular identification document;
- 30 (b) A passport from such person's country of origin;
- 31 (c) Any of the following documents in a language other than English,

1 but with an accompanying English translation:

- 2 (i) A foreign birth certificate;
- 3 (ii) A foreign federal electoral card;
- 4 (iii) A foreign driver's license;
- 5 (iv) A foreign national identification card;
- 6 (v) A marriage certificate or divorce decree; and
- 7 (vi) Any similar document from such person's country of origin.
- 8 (d) A photo identification card from a school or place of employment
- 9 <u>from within United States;</u>
- 10 (e) Documentation from the United States Citizenship and Immigration
- 11 <u>Services; and</u>
- 12 <u>(f) Any other documents approved by the director.</u>
- 13 (4) A person who is a federally authorized alien shall prove that
- 14 <u>such person is a Nebraska resident as required by this section with any</u>
- 15 two of the following documents that contain such person's principal
- 16 address:
- 17 (a) An account statement from a bank or other financial institution
- 18 issued within the last ninety days;
- 19 <u>(b) A pay stub or earnings statement issued within the last ninety</u>
- 20 <u>days with the name and address of such person's employer;</u>
- 21 (c) A federal, state, or local government document issued within the
- 22 last ninety days, including receipts;
- 23 <u>(d) A subscription magazine or newspaper issued within the last</u>
- 24 <u>ninety days;</u>
- (e) Any envelope, box, or postcard that has been sent indicating a
- 26 <u>postmark or stamped date within the last ninety days;</u>
- 27 <u>(f) A valid registration in Nebraska of a motor vehicle;</u>
- 28 (g) A valid insurance policy or card;
- 29 (h) Any valid license;
- 30 (i) A mortgage, lease, or rental agreement;
- 31 (j) A blank bank check or deposit slip;

1 (k) A document issued from an educational institution within the

- 2 last ninety days;
- 3 (1) Any utility, cellular telephone, or other bill issued within the
- 4 last ninety days;
- 5 (m) A change of address confirmation from the United States Postal
- 6 Service listing such person's current and prior address; and
- 7 (n) Any other document approved by the director.
- 8 (5) Except as otherwise provided, any eligibility requirement that
- 9 applies to an operator's license shall apply to the driving privilege
- 10 card and a person who is a federally authorized alien shall meet all
- 11 <u>other requirements to operate a motor vehicle, including successful</u>
- 12 completion of an examination required pursuant to section 60-4,113,
- 13 possessing sufficient powers of eyesight pursuant to section 60-4,118,
- 14 and application of the points system pursuant to 60-4,182.
