- 9 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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- 1 Section 1. DEFINITION OF APPROPRIATION PERIOD.
- 2 <u>For purposes of this act and any other legislative bill passed by</u>
- 3 the One Hundred Eighth Legislature, First Special Session, which
- 4 appropriates funds, FY2023-24 means the period July 1, 2023, through June
- 5 <u>30, 2024; FY2024-25 means the period July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2025;</u>
- 6 FY2025-26 means the period July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2026; and
- 7 FY2026-27 means the period July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027.
- 8 Sec. 2. APPROPRIATION LANGUAGE.
- 9 There are hereby appropriated, for FY2023-24 and FY2024-25, the sums
- 10 set forth in this act to each agency for each program from the respective
- 11 <u>funds for the general operations of state government, state aid, capital</u>
- 12 <u>construction projects, land acquisition, lease-purchase arrangements, and</u>
- 13 major equipment acquisition, except as otherwise appropriated.
- 14 Sec. 3. UNEXPENDED BALANCES AND CERTIFIED ENCUMBRANCES.
- 15 All General Fund appropriations existing on June 30, 2023, in excess
- 16 of expended and certified encumbrance amounts are hereby lapsed unless
- 17 otherwise provided. All Cash Fund and Revolving Fund appropriations
- 18 existing on June 30, 2023, in excess of expended and certified
- 19 <u>encumbrance amounts are hereby lapsed unless otherwise expressly</u>
- 20 provided. All certified encumbrance amounts on June 30, 2023, and June
- 21 30, 2024, are hereby reappropriated for FY2023-24 and FY2024-25,
- 22 respectively, which amounts shall be in addition to the amounts shown in
- 23 this act.
- 24 Sec. 4. REAPPROPRIATION OF BALANCE, FY2023-24 to FY2024-25.
- 25 In addition to the appropriations set forth in this act, there are
- 26 hereby reappropriated all unexpended appropriation balances existing on
- 27 June 30, 2024, for FY2024-25, to the respective agencies, programs, and
- 28 funds listed in this act, except as otherwise provided.
- 29 Sec. 5. <u>NEBRASKA ACCOUNTING SYSTEM MANUAL DEFINITIONS.</u>
- 30 The definitions contained in the Nebraska Accounting System Manual,
- 31 and any amendments thereto, on file with the Clerk of the Legislature,

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1 are hereby adopted by the Legislature as the definitions for this act,

- 2 <u>except as provided in section 6 of this act.</u>
- 3 Sec. 6. <u>LIMITATION ON SALARIES, WAGES, AND PER DIEMS.</u>
- 4 (1) For purposes of this act, (a) SALARY LIMIT shall mean total
- 5 expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems and (b)
- 6 total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
- 7 shall mean all remuneration paid to employees treated as taxable
- 8 compensation by the Internal Revenue Service or subject to social
- 9 security coverage, specifically including payments accounted for as
- 10 vacation, holidays, sick leave, military leave, funeral leave, maternity
- 11 leave, administrative leave, compensatory time, deferred compensation, or
- 12 <u>any other similar form, and amounts withheld pursuant to law, but</u>
- 13 excluding state contributions for social security, retirement, and
- 14 <u>employee insurance plans.</u>
- 15 (2) Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per
- 16 diems shall be limited to the amount shown except when federal funds in
- 17 excess of the amount shown are available and approved by the Governor.
- 18 Expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems from such
- 19 grants shall be in addition to the limitation on permanent and temporary
- 20 <u>salaries and per diems otherwise shown in this act. No agency shall</u>
- 21 request any state funds for continuation or replacement of any such
- 22 personnel or activities in future budget requests. To the extent
- 23 feasible, requests for increases in the limitation on permanent and
- 24 temporary salaries and per diems shall be addressed to the Appropriations
- 25 Committee of the Legislature when the Legislature is in session.
- 26 (3) Expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries resulting from
- 27 <u>awards made to employees under sections 81-1346 to 81-1354 shall be in</u>
- 28 <u>addition to the limitations on permanent and temporary salaries and per</u>
- 29 <u>diems otherwise shown in this act.</u>
- 30 (4) The limitation on expenditures for permanent and temporary
- 31 salaries and per diems for FY2024-25 as enumerated in this act shall be

1 the basis for continuation funding for each fiscal year of the succeeding

- 2 biennium.
- 3 (5) The limitation on expenditures for permanent and temporary
- 4 salaries and per diems for FY2023-24 shall be increased by certified
- 5 encumbrance amounts from FY2022-23 for permanent and temporary salaries
- 6 and per diems. The limitation on expenditures for permanent and temporary
- 7 salaries and per diems for FY2024-25 shall be increased by certified
- 8 <u>encumbrance amounts from FY2023-24 for permanent and temporary salaries</u>
- 9 and per diems. Encumbered amounts shall be calculated in accordance with
- 10 section 81-138.01.
- 11 (6) The limitation on expenditures for permanent and temporary
- 12 salaries and per diems shall only apply to remuneration paid to state
- 13 employees or per diem payments made to members of state boards or
- 14 commissions.
- 15 (7) The budget administrator of the budget division of the
- 16 <u>Department of Administrative Services may administratively increase the</u>
- 17 <u>limitation on expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per</u>
- 18 <u>diems upon receipt of a request for such increase from the director of a</u>
- 19 <u>state agency certifying the actual amount of the payment to a former</u>
- 20 employee of such agency, or such employee's beneficiary upon the death of
- 21 the employee, of accumulated vacation and sick leave pursuant to section
- 22 81-1325 and the rules and regulations of the State Personnel System
- 23 governing such payments.
- Sec. 7. DRAWING AND PAYING WARRANTS.
- 25 The Director of Administrative Services shall draw warrants upon the
- 26 proper fund in the state treasury for an amount not to exceed the
- 27 appropriations set forth in this act upon presentation of proper
- 28 <u>documentation</u>. The State Treasurer shall pay the warrants out of the
- 29 <u>appropriate funds.</u>
