- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to veterans memorials; to amend section
- 2 80-201, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change a provision
- 3 relating to the erection of statues, monuments, and memorials; to
- 4 create a commission; to authorize grants; and to repeal the original
- 5 section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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Section 1. Section 80-201, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 1

- 2 amended to read:
- 80-201 All counties, townships, cities, and villages of Nebraska may 3
- erect or aid in the erection of statues, monuments, or other memorials 4
- commemorating the services of the members of the armed forces of the 5
- 6 Civil, Spanish-American, or World Wars or the Korean or Vietnam conflict,
- 7 to veterans defined in section 80-401.01. Such statues, monuments, or
- memorials shall be located upon the public lands or within the public 8
- 9 buildings within such county, township, city, or village.
- 10 Sec. 2. (1) The Fallen Heroes Memorial Commission is created. The
- commission shall consist of five members. The Governor shall appoint the 11
- members of the commission with the approval of the members of the 12
- Legislature. The Governor is encouraged to appoint veterans to the 13
- commission. Members of the commission shall serve terms of four years, 14
- 15 except that the Governor shall stagger the terms of the initial
- appointees. A member may be reappointed to serve only one additional 16
- 17 term. Members shall not receive compensation for serving on the
- commission, but shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary 18
- 19 expenses as provided in sections 81-1174 to 81-1177. The commission shall
- elect from its members a chairperson and vice-chairperson. 20
- (2) The Fallen Heroes Memorial Construction Fund is created. The 21
- 22 fund shall be used to provide matching funds for the design and
- construction of statues, monuments, or memorials erected pursuant to 23
- 24 section 80-201 to recognize members of the armed services who lost their
- 25 lives in armed conflict. The fund shall consist of money appropriated by
- the Legislature and funds received by the commission as gifts, grants, or 26
- 27 donations. Any money in the fund available for investment shall be
- invested by the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital 28
- Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act. 29
- 30 (3) The commission shall establish an application procedure for
- counties, townships, cities, and villages to apply for grants to aid in 31

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- 1 <u>erection of such statues, monuments, and memorials. Subject to available</u>
- 2 <u>funds</u>, the commission may approve grants of up to one-third of the cost
- 3 of design and construction of such a statue, monument, or memorial. No
- 4 <u>such funds shall be expended for maintenance of the statue, monument, or</u>
- 5 <u>memorial or the surrounding area.</u>
- 6 (4) The commission may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to
- 7 <u>carry out this section.</u>
- 8 Sec. 3. Original section 80-201, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 9 Nebraska, is repealed.
