## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 242**

Introduced by Bolz, 29. Read first time January 11, 2017 Committee:

- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds for
  the recruitment of students who study to become behavioral health
  professionals; and to require reports.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. <u>There is hereby appropriated (1) \$598,803 from the</u>
2	<u>General Fund for FY2017-18 and (2) \$598,803 from the General Fund for</u>
3	FY2018-19 to the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska to be
4	used for the recruitment of students who study to become behavioral
5	<u>health professionals.</u>
6	<u>The University of Nebraska shall use such funds to develop and</u>
7	offer, in partnership with the Department of Correctional Services,
8	clinical rotations at correctional facilities for students who are
9	studying to become behavioral health professionals and to provide
10	stipends, clinical supervision, coordination, and other recruitment
11	services for such students. The Board of Regents shall include a report
12	on the outcomes of such recruitment efforts with its biennial budget
13	requests submitted in 2020 and 2022. Each such report shall include
14	information on whether the students that participated in the clinical
15	rotations stayed in this state to work as behavioral health professionals
16	<u>upon graduation.</u>
