A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to the Commission on Indian Affairs; to amend
2 section 81-2514, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
3 2010; to appropriate funds to the Designated Collection
4 Fund; to repeal the original section; and to declare an
5 emergency.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 81-2514, Revised Statutes Cumulative
2 Supplement, 2010, is amended to read:

3 81-2514 (1) The State Treasurer shall for FY2010-11
4 transfer on July 15, 2010, twenty-five thousand dollars from the
5 General Fund to the Designated Collection Fund which is hereby
6 created. The State Treasurer shall for FY2011-12 transfer on July 15,
7 2011, fifteen thousand dollars from the General Fund to the
8 Designated Collection Fund. Any money in the fund available for
9 investment shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant
10 to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds
11 Investment Act.

12 (2) The commission may accept and shall actively seek,
13 for the needs listed in section 81-2510, any and all grants,
14 donations, gifts, or contributions from public or private sources.
15 Any such grants, donations, gifts, or contributions shall be
16 deposited in the Designated Collection Fund and shall only be
17 expended as provided in sections 81-2509 to 81-2515.

18 Sec. 2. Original section 81-2514, Revised Statutes
19 Cumulative Supplement, 2010, is repealed.

20 Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
21 when passed and approved according to law.
