# **LEGISLATIVE BILL 315**

Introduced by Fredrickson, 20; Day, 49; Hughes, 24. Read first time January 11, 2023

### Committee:

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to relating to public health and welfare; to
- 2 prohibit providers of services relating to examination or treatment
- 3 of injuries arising from sexual assault, domestic assault, and child
- 4 abuse from taking actions relating to victims' debts for such
- 5 services.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) A health care provider, an emergency medical
- 2 <u>services provider</u>, a <u>laboratory</u>, <u>or a pharmacy providing medical</u>
- 3 services, transportation, medications, or other services related to the
- 4 examination or treatment of injuries arising out of sexual assault as
- 5 <u>defined in section 29-4309</u>, <u>domestic assault under section 28-323</u>, <u>or</u>
- 6 child abuse under section 28-707 shall not:
- 7 <u>(a) Refer a bill for such services to a collection agency or an</u>
- 8 attorney for collection against the victim or the victim's guardian or
- 9 <u>family;</u>
- 10 <u>(b) Distribute information regarding such services and status of</u>
- 11 payment in any way that would affect the credit rating of the victim or
- 12 the victim's guardian or family;
- 13 (c) Take any other action adverse to the victim or the victim's
- 14 guardian or family on account of providing such services.
- 15 (2) This section shall not be construed to prevent an entity
- 16 described in subsection (1) of this section from otherwise seeking
- 17 payment for such services from the victim or any other source.
