1	Section 1. (1) Any contract exceeding fifty thousand dollars for
2	the construction, reconstruction, improvement, maintenance, or repair of
3	<u>a road, street, highway, bridge, or other related structure to which the</u>
4	Department of Transportation or any city of the metropolitan class, any
5	<u>city of the primary class, any city of the first class, or any county</u>
6	with more than twenty-five thousand inhabitants is a party shall require
7	<u>a utility coordination plan. Such plan shall identify any utility</u>
8	operator, its facilities, and the location and elevation of such
9	facilities within the project work area or which are otherwise affected
10	by any construction, reconstruction, improvement, maintenance, or repair
11	project conducted under such contract and the date or dates such
12	facilities will be relocated or removed. A contractor performing services
13	under the contract may rely on such plan and shall be compensated by the
14	Department of Transportation or such city or county for any costs or
15	damages associated with any deviation or failure by the department or
16	such city or county to follow the plan.

(a) Facility means personal property above or below ground for use 18 19 in connection with the storage or conveyance of water, sewage, electronic communications, telephonic communications, telegraphic communications, 20 cable television, electric energy, oil, gas, hazardous liquids, or other 21 substances and includes pipes, trunk lines, fiber optic cables, sewers, 22 23 conduits, cables, valves, lines, wires, manholes, and attachments to such 24 personal property; and 25 (b) Utility operator includes any entity that owns or operates a
