Section 1. Section 85-1906, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

85-1906 (1) Eligible postsecondary educational institution means a
public or private postsecondary educational institution:

5 <u>(a)</u> (1) Located in Nebraska;

(b) (2) Primarily engaged in the instruction of students;

7 <u>(c)</u> (3) Satisfying the provisions of Nebraska law relating to the 8 approval and licensure of schools, colleges, and universities and 9 maintaining accreditation by an accrediting organization recognized by 10 the United States Department of Education;

(d) (4) Offering courses of instruction in regularly scheduled
 classes to regularly enrolled undergraduate students who reside in
 Nebraska and have received high school diplomas or their equivalent; and

(e) (5) Which has adopted, and has available for inspection, award
 refund and repayment policies.

16 (2) For a postsecondary educational institution not eligible prior
 17 to the effective date of this act, for purposes of this section, located
 18 in Nebraska means such eligible postsecondary educational institution:

(a) Has established a physical location in this state where students
 may receive instruction; and

(b) Maintains an administrative office in this state for the
 purposes of enrolling students, providing information to students about
 the institution, and providing student support services.

24 Sec. 2. Section 85-1907, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 25 amended to read:

26 85-1907 Eligible student means an undergraduate student who:

27 (1) Is enrolled in an eligible postsecondary educational28 institution;

29 <u>(2)(a) For award years through award year 2023-24, has</u> 30 applied for federal financial aid through the Free Application for 31 Federal Student Aid for the applicable award year and has an expected

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1 family contribution which is equal to or less than one hundred ten
2 percent of the maximum expected family contribution to qualify for a
3 Federal Pell Grant in that award year; and

4 (b) For award year 2024-25 and each award year thereafter, has 5 applied for federal financial aid through the Free Application for 6 Federal Student Aid for the applicable award year and has a student aid 7 index which is equal to or less than one hundred ten percent of the 8 maximum student aid index to qualify for a Federal Pell Grant in that 9 award year;

10 (3) Is a resident student who is domiciled in Nebraska as provided11 by section 85-502; and

(4) Complies with all other provisions of the Nebraska OpportunityGrant Act and its rules and regulations.
