Section 1. Section 32-630, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 32-630 (1) Each person who signs a petition shall, at the time of and in addition to signing, personally affix the date, print his or her 4 last name and first name in full, and affix his or her date of birth and 5 address, including the street and number or a designation of a rural 6 7 route or voting precinct and the city or village or a post office address. A person signing a petition may use his or her initials in place 8 9 of his or her first name if such person is registered to vote under such initials. No signer shall use ditto marks as a means of personally 10 affixing the date or address to any petition. A wife shall not use her 11 husband's first name when she signs a petition but shall personally affix 12 13 her first name and her last name by marriage or her surname. Any signature using ditto marks as a means of personally affixing the date or 14 address of any petition or any signature using a spouse's first name 15 instead of his or her own shall be invalid. 16

17 (2) Each circulator of a petition shall personally witness the18 signatures on the petition and shall sign the circulator's affidavit.

19 (3) No person shall:

20 (a) Sign any name other than his or her own to any petition;

(b) Knowingly sign his or her name more than once for the same
petition effort or measure;

(c) Sign a petition if he or she is not a registered voter and
qualified to sign the same except as provided in section 32-1404;

25 (d) Falsely swear to any signature upon any such petition;

26 (e) Accept money or other thing of value for signing any petition;

(f) Offer money or other thing of value in exchange for a signatureupon any petition; or

29 (g) Pay a circulator based on the number of signatures collected.

30 <u>(4) To protect the right of a citizen to sign a petition:</u>

31 (a) No person shall harass, intimidate, or impede a circulator of a

1 petition within two hundred feet of the circulator;

2 (b) If a circulator is stationary at a fixed table or booth, no
3 person shall prevent the circulator from talking to any person or prevent
4 any person from approaching the circulator; and

5 (c) No person shall do any electioneering within two hundred feet of
6 a circulator.

Sec. 2. Section 32-1546, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, isamended to read:

9 32-1546 (1) Any person who is not, at the time of signing a 10 petition, a registered voter and qualified to sign the petition, except 11 as provided for initiative and referendum petitions in section 32-1404, 12 or who signs any name other than his or her own to any petition shall be 13 guilty of a Class I misdemeanor.

(2) Any person who falsely swears to a circulator's affidavit on a
petition, who accepts money or other things of value for signing a
petition, or who offers money or other things of value in exchange for a
signature upon any petition shall be guilty of a Class IV felony.

18 (3) Any person who (a) harasses, intimidates, or impedes a 19 circulator of a petition within two hundred feet of the circulator, (b) 20 who prevents a circulator from talking to any person or prevents any 21 person from approaching the circulator if the circulator is stationary at 22 a fixed table or booth, or (c) does any electioneering within two hundred 23 feet of a circulator shall be guilty of a Class V misdemeanor.
