- 1 Section 1. (1) It shall be an unlawful employment practice for a
- 2 covered entity to discriminate or retaliate against an individual because
- 3 such individual has reported a work-related injury, brought a claim, or
- 4 sought remedies under the Nebraska Workers' Compensation Act.
- 5 (2) The rights and remedies provided by the Nebraska Fair Employment
- 6 Practice Act are supplemental to those provided in the Nebraska Workers'
- 7 Compensation Act.
- 8 Sec. 2. <u>In any civil action brought under the Nebraska Fair</u>
- 9 Employment Practice Act, there shall be a right to a jury trial,
- 10 including in cases brought against state and governmental agencies.
- 11 Sec. 3. Section 48-1126, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 12 amended to read:
- 13 48-1126 The state and governmental agencies created by the state may
- 14 be sued upon claims arising under the Nebraska Fair Employment Practice
- 15 Act in the same manner as provided by such law for suits against other
- 16 employers.
- 17 Sec. 4. Section 48-1125, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 18 amended to read:
- 19 48-1125 Sections 48-1101 to 48-1125 and sections 1 to 3 of this act
- 20 shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Fair Employment Practice
