**LEGISLATIVE BILL 386**

Introduced by Lathrop, 12; at the request of the Governor.

Read first time January 14, 2021

Committee:

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to judges' salaries; to amend section
- 2 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020; to change
- 3 judges' salaries; to provide an operative date; to repeal the
- 4 original section; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative  
2 Supplement, 2020, is amended to read:

3 24-201.01 ~~On January 1, 2019, the salary of the Chief Justice and~~  
4 ~~the judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred seventy-six thousand~~  
5 ~~two hundred ninety-nine dollars and thirty-eight cents. On July 1, 2019,~~  
6 ~~the salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall~~  
7 ~~be one hundred eighty-one thousand five hundred eighty-eight dollars and~~  
8 ~~thirty-six cents. On July 1, 2020, the salary of the Chief Justice and~~  
9 the judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred eighty-seven  
10 thousand thirty-six dollars and one cent. On July 1, 2021, the salary of  
11 the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall be one  
12 hundred ninety-two thousand six hundred forty-seven dollars and nine  
13 cents. On July 1, 2022, the salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of  
14 the Supreme Court shall be one hundred ninety-eight thousand four hundred  
15 twenty-six dollars and fifty-one cents.

16 The Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall hold no  
17 other public office of profit or trust during their terms of office nor  
18 accept any public appointment or employment under the authority of the  
19 government of the United States for which they receive compensation for  
20 their services. Such salaries shall be payable in equal monthly  
21 installments.

22 Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2021.

23 Sec. 3. Original section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative  
24 Supplement, 2020, is repealed.

25 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when  
26 passed and approved according to law.
