- 3 60-6,279 A-(1) A person shall not operate a motorcycle or
- 4 moped on any highway in this state unless such person is wearing eye
- 5 protection.
- 6 (2) Except as otherwise provided in subsections (3) and
- 7 (4) of this section, a person shall not operate or be a passenger on
- 8 a motorcycle or moped on any highway in this state unless such person
- 9 is wearing a protective helmet of the type and design manufactured
- 10 for use by operators of such vehicles and unless such helmet is
- 11 secured properly on his or her head with a chin strap while the
- 12 vehicle is in motion. All such protective helmets shall be designed
- 13 to reduce injuries to the user resulting from head impacts and shall
- 14 be designed to protect the user by remaining on the user's head,
- 15 deflecting blows, resisting penetration, and spreading the force of
- 16 impact. Each such helmet shall consist of lining, padding, and chin
- 17 strap and shall meet or exceed the standards established in the
- 18 United States Department of Transportation's Federal Motor Vehicle
- 19 Safety Standard No. 218, 49 C.F.R. 571.218, for motorcycle helmets.
- 20 (3) A person who is at least twenty-one years of age is
- 21 <u>exempt from subsection (2) of this section.</u>
- 22 (4) For purposes of this section, eye protection means
- 23 glasses that cover the orbital region of a person's face, a
- 24 protective face shield attached to a protective helmet, goggles, or a
- 25 windshield on the motorcycle or moped that protects the operator's

- 1 and passenger's horizontal line of vision in all operating positions.
- 2 (5) A person exempt from subsection (2) of this section
- 3 shall have the words "helmet not required" printed on his or her
- 4 Class M operator's license or on his or her operator's license
- 5 <u>underneath the Class M endorsement.</u>
