Committee:

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; to amend section 60-6,268,
- 2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2016; to change child
- 3 passenger restraint system enforcement from a secondary offense to a
- 4 primary offense; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-6,268, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
2 2016, is amended to read:

3 60-6,268 (1) A person violating any provision of subsection (1) or
4 (2) of section 60-6,267 shall be guilty of an infraction as defined in
5 section 29-431 and shall be fined fifty ~~twenty-five~~ dollars for each
6 violation. The failure to provide a child restraint system for more than
7 one child in the same vehicle at the same time, as required in such
8 subsection, shall not be treated as a separate offense.

9 (2) Enforcement of subsection ~~(2) or~~ (8) of section 60-6,267 shall
10 be accomplished only as a secondary action when an operator of a motor
11 vehicle has been cited or charged with a violation or some other offense
12 unless the violation involves a person under the age of eighteen years
13 riding in or on any portion of the vehicle not designed or intended for
14 the use of passengers when the vehicle is in motion.
