- 3 (1) There is created within the Department of Health and 43-404
- Human Services the Office of Juvenile Services. The office shall have 4
- 5 oversight and control of the youth rehabilitation and treatment centers.
- The Administrator of the Office of Juvenile Services shall be appointed 6
- 7 by the chief executive officer of the department or his or her designee
- and shall be responsible for the administration of the facilities and 8
- 9 programs of the office. The department may subcontract with a state
- 10 agency or private provider to provide services related to the facilities
- and programs of the Office of Juvenile Services. 11
- (2) Prior to implementing any substantial changes to the facilities 12
- 13 and programs under the jurisdiction of the Office of Juvenile Services,
- the Department of Health and Human Services shall notify the Legislature 14
- of such intended substantial changes. The notification shall be submitted 15
