Section 1. Section 71-1913.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,

3 71-1913.01 (1) Each program shall require the parent or quardian of each child enrolled in such program to present within thirty days after 4 enrollment and periodically thereafter (a) proof that the child is 5 by age-appropriate immunization against measles, 6 protected rubella, poliomyelitis, diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus, 7 haemophilus influenzae type B, and invasive pneumococcal disease and such other 8 9 diseases as the department may from time to time specify based on then current medical and scientific knowledge, or (b) certification by a 10 physician, an advanced practice registered nurse practicing under and in 11 accordance with his or her respective certification act, or a physician 12 13 assistant that immunization is not appropriate for a stated medical 14 reason, or (c) a written statement that the parent or quardian does not wish to have such child so immunized and the reasons therefor. The 15 16 program shall exclude a child from attendance until such proof \underline{or}_{T} certification, or written statement is provided. At the time the parent 17 or guardian is notified that such information is required, he or she 18 19 shall be notified in writing of his or her right to submit a certification or written statement pursuant to subdivision (b) or (c) of 20 21 this subsection.

22 (2) Each program shall keep <u>on file</u>the written record immunization or , the certification, or the written statement of the 23 24 parent or guardian. Such record, or certification, or statement shall be kept by the program as part of the child's file, shall be available 25 onsite to the department, and shall be filed with the department for 26 review and inspection. Each program shall report electronically to the 27 department by November 1 of each year the status of immunization for 28 29 children enrolled as of September 30 of that year, and children who have reached kindergarten age and who are enrolled in public or private school 30 31 need not be included in the report.

- 1 (3) The department shall maintain a data base for the submission of
- 2 the report required for each program under subsection (2) of this
- 3 <u>section</u>. Any identification of individual children in such reports shall
- 4 <u>not be public information.</u>
