1 Section 1. Sections 1 to 7 of this act shall be known and

- 2 may be cited as the Nebraska Career Technical Education Grant Program
- 3 <u>Act.</u>
- 4 Sec. 2. For purposes of the Nebraska Career Technical
- 5 Education Grant Program Act:
- 6 (1) Board means the Community College Board of Governors
- 7 <u>for each community college area;</u>
- 8 (2) Career technical education grant means the award of a
- 9 <u>financial grant pursuant to the act;</u>
- 10 (3) Commission shall mean the Coordinating Commission for
- 11 Postsecondary Education;
- 12 (4) Critical industry field program means a program that
- 13 trains future workers for careers in technical fields that currently
- or are projected to be in high demand of skilled workers;
- 15 (5) Designated career technical education program means a
- 16 program operated at an eligible institution in a critical industry
- 17 field program as identified by the commission and the Department of
- 18 <u>Labor pursuant to section 4 of this act;</u>
- 19 (6) Eligible institution means a community college
- 20 governed by a Community College Board of Governors or a community
- 21 <u>college operated by a tribal authority in Nebraska; and</u>
- 22 (7) Eligible student means an individual enrolled in at
- 23 least twelve credit hours within a twelve-month period and who meets
- 24 <u>additional criteria developed by the commission.</u>
- 25 Sec. 3. The purposes of the Nebraska Career Technical

1	Education	Grant	Program	are	to:

- 2 (1) Provide financial assistance in the form of career
- 3 technical education grants to attract students to specific designated
- 4 career technical education programs at community colleges in Nebraska
- 5 in order to prepare workers for careers in critical industry fields
- 6 in Nebraska;
- 7 (2) Work with business and industry organizations to
- 8 identify critical industry fields in Nebraska that are in need of or
- 9 will be in need of highly skilled workers now and in the future;
- 10 (3) Provide employers in Nebraska with on-demand
- 11 availability of skilled workers and industry with a steady pipeline
- 12 <u>of talent development; and</u>
- 13 (4) Provide for cooperating with business and industry
- organizations to fund the program now and in the future.
- Sec. 4. (1) The Nebraska Career Technical Education Grant
- 16 Program is created. The commission shall administer the program. To
- 17 be eligible for a career technical education grant from the program,
- 18 <u>an eligible student shall:</u>
- 19 (a) Be enrolled in classes in a designated career
- 20 technical education program at an eligible institution; and
- 21 (b) Intend to work in a business or industry in a
- 22 critical industry field in Nebraska upon successful completion of a
- 23 <u>designated career technical education program at an eligible</u>
- 24 <u>institution</u>.
- 25 (2) An eligible student may apply annually for a grant

1 from the program in an amount of not more than one thousand dollars

- 2 per academic year.
- 3 (3) The commission in conjunction with the Department of
- 4 Labor and eligible institutions shall identify critical industry
- 5 fields. The commission shall by rule and regulation provide a process
- 6 for applying for grants and for granting or denying such applications
- 7 and guidelines for distribution of such grants to successful
- 8 <u>applicants.</u>
- 9 Sec. 5. The commission shall file an annual report with
- 10 the Clerk of the Legislature containing information on the number of
- 11 career technical education grants awarded each year, details on the
- 12 <u>designated career technical education programs taken by the grantees,</u>
- 13 including the institutions in which the grantees are enrolled, and
- 14 profile information about the grantees.
- 15 Sec. 6. The Nebraska Career Technical Education Grant
- 16 Program Fund is created. The fund shall be used to carry out the
- 17 purposes of the Nebraska Career Technical Education Grant Program
- 18 Act. The commission may solicit and receive donations from
- 19 individuals, businesses, nonprofit organizations, or other sources
- 20 for credit to the fund. Individuals, businesses, and nonprofit
- 21 organizations who or which donate to the fund may request that the
- 22 commission use such donated funds for specific programs at eliqible
- 23 institutions. Any money in the fund available for investment shall be
- 24 <u>invested</u> by the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska
- 25 Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.

1 Sec. 7. The commission shall adopt and promulgate rules

- 2 and regulations to carry out the Nebraska Career Technical Education
- 3 Grant Program Act.
- 4 Sec. 8. Section 85-1412, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 5 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:
- 6 85-1412 The commission shall have the following
- 7 additional powers and duties:
- 8 (1) Conduct surveys and studies as may be necessary to
- $9\,$ undertake the coordination function of the commission pursuant to
- 10 section 85-1403 and request information from governing boards and
- 11 appropriate administrators of public institutions and other
- 12 governmental agencies for research projects. All public institutions
- 13 and governmental agencies receiving state funds shall comply with
- 14 reasonable requests for information under this subdivision. Public
- 15 institutions may comply with such requests pursuant to section
- 16 85-1417;
- 17 (2) Recommend to the Legislature and the Governor
- 18 legislation it deems necessary or appropriate to improve
- 19 postsecondary education in Nebraska and any other legislation it
- 20 deems appropriate to change the role and mission provisions in
- 21 sections 85-917 to 85-966.01. The recommendations submitted to the
- 22 Legislature shall be submitted electronically;
- 23 (3) Establish any advisory committees as may be necessary
- 24 to undertake the coordination function of the commission pursuant to
- 25 section 85-1403 or to solicit input from affected parties such as

1 students, faculty, governing boards, administrators of the public

- 2 institutions, administrators of the private nonprofit institutions of
- 3 postsecondary education and proprietary institutions in the state,
- 4 and community and business leaders regarding the coordination
- 5 function of the commission;
- 6 (4) Participate in or designate an employee or employees
- 7 to participate in any committee which may be created to prepare a
- 8 coordinated plan for the delivery of educational programs and
- 9 services in Nebraska through the telecommunications system;
- 10 (5) Seek a close liaison with the State Board of
- 11 Education and the State Department of Education in recognition of the
- 12 need for close coordination of activities between elementary and
- 13 secondary education and postsecondary education;
- 14 (6) Administer the Integrated Postsecondary Education
- 15 Data System or other information system or systems to provide the
- 16 commission with timely, comprehensive, and meaningful information
- 17 pertinent to the exercise of its duties. The information system shall
- 18 be designed to provide comparable data on each public institution.
- 19 The commission shall also administer the uniform information system
- 20 prescribed in sections 85-1421 to 85-1427 known as the Nebraska
- 21 Educational Data System. Public institutions shall supply the
- 22 appropriate data for the information system or systems required by
- 23 the commission;
- 24 (7) Administer the Access College Early Scholarship
- 25 Program Act, the Nebraska Career Technical Education Grant Program

1 Act, the Community College Aid Act, the Nebraska Opportunity Grant

- 2 Act, and the Postsecondary Institution Act;
- 3 (8) Accept and administer loans, grants, and programs
- 4 from the federal or state government and from other sources, public
- 5 and private, for carrying out any of its functions, including the
- 6 administration of privately endowed scholarship programs. Such loans
- 7 and grants shall not be expended for any other purposes than those
- 8 for which the loans and grants were provided. The commission shall
- 9 determine eligibility for such loans, grants, and programs, and such
- 10 loans and grants shall not be expended unless approved by the
- 11 Governor;
- 12 (9) On or before December 1 of each even-numbered year,
- 13 submit to the Legislature and the Governor a report of its objectives
- 14 and activities and any new private colleges in Nebraska and the
- 15 implementation of any recommendations of the commission for the
- 16 preceding two calendar years. The report submitted to the Legislature
- 17 shall be submitted electronically;
- 18 (10) Provide staff support for interstate compacts on
- 19 postsecondary education; and
- 20 (11) Request inclusion of the commission in any existing
- 21 grant review process and information system.
- 22 Sec. 9. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2013.
- Sec. 10. Original section 85-1412, Revised Statutes
- 24 Cumulative Supplement, 2012, is repealed.
- 25 Sec. 11. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect
