- 5 the original sections; and to declare an emergency.


1 Section 1. Section 75-101.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,

- 2 is amended to read:
- 3 75-101.01 (1) Based on the 2020 2010 Census of Population by the
- 4 United States Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census, the State of
- 5 Nebraska is hereby divided into five public service commissioner
- 6 districts, and each public service commissioner district shall be
- 7 entitled to one member.
- 8 (2) The numbers and boundaries of the districts are designated and
- 9 established by maps identified and labeled as maps PSC21-39001,
- 10 PSC21-39001-1, PSC21-39001-2, PSC21-39001-3, PSC21-39001-4, and
- 11 <u>PSC21-39001-5</u> <u>PSC11-1</u>, <u>PSC11-2</u>, <u>PSC11-3</u>, <u>PSC11-4</u>, <u>and PSC11-5</u>, filed with
- 12 the Clerk of the Legislature, and incorporated by reference as part of
- 13 <u>this legislative bill</u> <del>Laws 2011, LB700</del>.
- 14 (3)(a) The Clerk of the Legislature shall transfer possession of the
- 15 maps referred to in subsection (2) of this section to the Secretary of
- 16 State on the effective date of this act May 27, 2011.
- 17 (b) When questions of interpretation of district boundaries arise,
- 18 the maps referred to in subsection (2) of this section in possession of
- 19 the Secretary of State shall serve as the indication of the legislative
- 20 intent in drawing the district boundaries.
- 21 (c) Each election commissioner or county clerk shall obtain copies
- 22 of the maps referred to in subsection (2) of this section for the
- 23 election commissioner's or clerk's county from the Secretary of State.
- 24 (d) The Secretary of State shall also have available for viewing on
- 25 his or her website the maps referred to in subsection (2) of this section
- 26 identifying the boundaries for the districts.


