10 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 81-2509, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:
- 3 81-2509 For purposes of sections 81-2509 to 81-2515:
- 4 (1) Census designated place means a concentration of
- 5 population identified by the United States Department of Commerce,
- 6 Bureau of the Census, that lacks a separate municipal government but
- 7 otherwise physically resembles an incorporated city or village, that
- 8 is associated with an Indian reservation, and that is in a county
- 9 with fewer than six thousand four hundred inhabitants according to
- 10 the most recent federal decennial census;
- 11 $\frac{(2)}{(2)}$ (1) Commission means the Commission on Indian
- 12 Affairs;
- 13 $\frac{(3)}{(2)}$ Indian reservation means a tract of land set
- 14 apart by the federal government for the use of the Native American
- 15 people; and
- 16 $\frac{(4)-(3)}{(4)}$ Political subdivision means a city, village, or
- 17 county within a thirty-mile_sixty-mile_radius of a census-designated
- 18 place an Indian reservation or a tribal government that owns land
- 19 within such thirty-mile sixty-mile radius.
- 20 Sec. 2. Section 81-2510, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 21 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:
- 22 81-2510 Any political subdivision may annually apply to
- 23 the commission for state assistance under sections 81-2509 to
- 24 81-2515. The state assistance shall be used for economic development,
- 25 <u>education</u>, health care, and law enforcement needs in such political

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- 1 subdivision.
- 2 Sec. 3. Section 81-2513, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 3 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:
- 4 81-2513 (1) After consideration of the application, and
- 5 the evidence, the commission shall issue a finding of whether the use
- 6 described in the application is eligible for state assistance.
- 7 (2) If the commission finds that the use described in the
- 8 application is a legitimate use and that state assistance is in the
- 9 best interest of the state, the application shall be approved.
- 10 (3) A majority of the commission members constitutes a
- 11 quorum for the purpose of conducting business. All actions of the
- 12 commission shall be made by a majority vote of the voting members.
- 13 Sec. 4. Original sections 81-2509, 81-2510, and 81-2513,
- 14 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2012, are repealed.
