- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to health clinics; to amend section 71-401,
 2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2010; to require
- 3 patient transfer agreements as prescribed; and to repeal
- 4 the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 71-401, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2010, is amended to read:
- 3 71-401 Sections 71-401 to 71-465 <u>and section 2 of this</u>
- 4 act shall be known and may be cited as the Health Care Facility
- 5 Licensure Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. (1) In order to be licensed under the Health Care
- 7 Facility Licensure Act, a health clinic shall have a patient transfer
- 8 agreement in effect with a local hospital licensed under the Health
- 9 Care Facility Licensure Act. In order to be eligible to participate
- 10 in a patient transfer agreement with a health clinic, the hospital
- 11 shall accept patients whose care is reimbursed by medicare or provide
- 12 emergency room services and shall allow clinical privileges for the
- 13 physicians performing surgery at the health clinic. A patient
- 14 transfer agreement shall address procedures for appropriate transfer
- 15 of patients, continuity of care, and support for maintaining
- 16 emergency capacity, including on-call coverage. The department shall
- 17 <u>adopt and promulgate rules and regulations establishing requirements</u>
- 18 for patient transfer agreements and minimum requirements for a
- 19 hospital to be a party to a patient transfer agreement, including
- 20 reasonable distance parameters, emergency room services, and hospital
- 21 capacity.
- 22 (2) This section shall not apply to a public health
- 23 clinic operated by the department or any county, city-county, or
- 24 <u>multicounty health department.</u>
