### A BILL

- FOR AN ACT relating to tobacco; to amend sections 28-439, 28-1420, and 77-4007, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to restrict the use and sale of blunt wrap tobacco wrappers
- 4 as prescribed; and to repeal the original sections.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-439, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 28-439 As used in sections 28-101, 28-431, and 28-439 to
- 4 28-444, or elsewhere in the Nebraska Criminal Code, unless the
- 5 context otherwise requires, drug paraphernalia shall mean means all
- 6 equipment, products, and materials of any kind which are used,
- 7 intended for use, or designed for use, in manufacturing, injecting,
- 8 ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing into the human body a
- 9 controlled substance in violation of sections  $\frac{28-101}{}$ , 28-431, and
- 10 28-439 to 28-444 or the Uniform Controlled Substances Act. It shall
- 11 include, but not be limited to, the following:
- 12 (1) Diluents and adulterants, such as quinine
- 13 hydrochloride, mannitol, mannite, dextrose, and lactose, used,
- 14 intended for use, or designed for use in cutting controlled
- 15 substances;
- 16 (2) Separation gins and sifters used, intended for use,
- 17 or designed for use in removing twigs and seeds from, or in otherwise
- 18 cleaning or refining, marijuana;
- 19 (3) Hypodermic syringes, needles, and other objects used,
- 20 intended for use, and designed for use in parenterally injecting
- 21 controlled substances into the human body; and
- 22 (4) Objects used, intended for use, or designed for use
- 23 in ingesting, inhaling, or otherwise introducing marijuana, cocaine,
- 24 hashish, or hashish oil into the human body, which shall include but
- 25 not be limited to the following:

1 (a) Metal, wooden, acrylic, glass, stone, plastic, or

- 2 ceramic pipes with or without screens, permanent screens, hashish
- 3 heads, or punctured metal bowls;
- 4 (b) Water pipes;
- 5 (c) Carburetion tubes and devices;
- 6 (d) Smoking and carburetion masks;
- 7 (e) Roach clips, meaning objects used to hold burning
- 8 material, such as a marijuana cigarette, which has become too small
- 9 or too short to be held in the hand;
- 10 (f) Miniature cocaine spoons, and cocaine vials;
- 11 (g) Chamber pipes;
- 12 (h) Carburetor pipes;
- 13 (i) Electric pipes;
- 14 (j) Air-driven pipes;
- 15 (k) Chillums;
- 16 (1) Bongs; and
- 17 (m) Ice pipes or chillers; and -
- 18 <u>(n) Blunt wrap tobacco wrappers, meaning individual</u>
- 19 tobacco wrappers made wholly or in part from tobacco, including
- 20 reconstituted tobacco, in the form of a tobacco leaf, sheet, or tube,
- 21 <u>if such a wrap is designed to be sold to individuals.</u>
- 22 Sec. 2. Section 28-1420, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 23 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 24 28-1420 (1) It shall be unlawful for any person,
- 25 partnership, limited liability company, or corporation to sell, keep

1 for sale, or give away in course of trade, any cigars, tobacco,

- 2 cigarettes, or cigarette material to anyone without first obtaining a
- 3 license as provided in sections 28-1421 and 28-1422.
- 4 (2) It shall also be unlawful for any wholesaler to sell
- 5 or deliver any cigars, tobacco, cigarettes, or cigarette material to
- 6 any person, partnership, limited liability company, or corporation
- 7 who, at the time of such sale or delivery, is not the recipient of a
- 8 valid tobacco license for the current year to retail the same as
- 9 provided in such sections.
- 10 (3) It shall also be unlawful for any person,
- 11 partnership, limited liability company, or corporation to purchase or
- 12 receive, for purposes of resale, any cigars, tobacco, cigarettes, or
- 13 cigarette material if such person, partnership, limited liability
- 14 company, or corporation is not the recipient of a valid tobacco
- 15 license to retail such tobacco products at the time the same are
- 16 purchased or received.
- 17 (4) Cigars, tobacco, or tobacco products shall not
- 18 include blunt wrap tobacco wrappers made wholly or in part from
- 19 tobacco, including reconstituted tobacco, in the form of a tobacco
- 20 leaf, sheet, or tube, if such a wrap is designed to be sold to
- 21 <u>individuals</u>.
- 22 <u>(5)</u> Whoever shall be found guilty of violating this
- 23 section shall be guilty of a Class III misdemeanor for each offense.
- Sec. 3. Section 77-4007, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 25 Nebraska, is amended to read:

- 1 77-4007 Tobacco products shall mean (1) cigars, (2)
- 2 cheroots, (3) stogies, (4) periques, (5) granulated, plug cut, crimp
- 3 cut, ready rubbed, and other smoking tobacco, (6) snuff, (7) snuff
- 4 flour, (8) cavendish, (9) plug and twist tobacco, (10) fine cut and
- 5 other chewing tobacco, (11) shorts, refuse scraps, clippings,
- 6 cuttings, and sweepings of tobacco, and (12) other kinds and forms of
- 7 tobacco, prepared in such manner as to be suitable for chewing or
- 8 smoking in a pipe or otherwise or both for chewing and smoking,
- 9 except that tobacco products shall not mean cigarettes as defined in
- 10 section 77-2601 or blunt wrap tobacco wrappers.
- 11 Sec. 4. Original sections 28-439, 28-1420, and 77-4007,
- 12 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
