Section 25-2602.01, Revised Statutes 2 Cumulative Supplement, 2012, is amended to read: 3 25-2602.01 (a) A written agreement to submit any existing controversy to arbitration is valid, enforceable, and irrevocable 4 5 except upon such grounds as exist at law or in equity for the б revocation of any contract. 7 (b) A provision in a written contract to submit to 8 arbitration any controversy thereafter arising between the parties is valid, enforceable, and irrevocable, except upon such grounds as 9 exist at law or in equity for the revocation of any contract, if the 10 11 provision is entered into voluntarily and willingly. 12 (c) The Uniform Arbitration Act applies to arbitration 13 agreements between employers and employees or between their 14 respective representatives. (d) Contract provisions agreed to by the parties to a 15 contract control over contrary provisions of the act other than 16 17 subsections (e) and (f) of this section. (e) Subsections (a) and (b) of this section do not apply 18 to<u>:</u> a 19 20 (i) A claim for workers' compensation; or -(ii) A claim involving disciplinary action against a 21 22 peace officer. 23 (f) Subsection (b) of this section does not apply to: (1) A claim arising out of personal injury based on tort; 24

(3) Any agreement between parties covered by the Motor

7 (g) When a conflict exists, the Uniform Arbitration Act 8 shall not apply to the Uniform Act on Interstate Arbitration and 9 Compromise of Death Taxes and sections 44-811, 44-4824, 54-404 to 10 54-406, 60-2701 to 60-2709, and 70-1301 to 70-1329.
