Read first time January 18, 2017 Committee: A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend section 28-1310, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change provisions relating to intimidation by telephone call; to provide for

4 intimidation by electronic message; and to repeal the original

Section 1. Section 28-1310, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

28-1310 (1) A person commits the offense of intimidation by
telephone call <u>or electronic message</u> if, with intent to terrify,
intimidate, threaten, <u>or harass, annoy, or offend</u>, the person:

6 (a) Telephones <u>or transmits an electronic message directly to</u> 7 another anonymously, whether or not conversation <u>or an electronic</u> 8 <u>response</u>ensues, and disturbs the peace, quiet, and right of privacy of 9 any person at the place where the calls <u>or electronic messages</u> are 10 received;—or

(b) Telephones <u>or transmits an electronic message directly to</u>
 another and uses <u>indecent</u>, <u>lewd</u>, <u>lascivious</u>, <u>or</u> obscene language or
 suggests any <u>obscene</u> <u>indecent</u>, <u>lewd</u>, <u>or lascivious</u> act;<u>or</u>

(c) Telephones <u>or transmits an electronic message directly to</u>
another and threatens to inflict injury to any person or to the property
of any person; or

17 (d) Intentionally fails to disengage the connection; or

(e) Telephones <u>or transmits an electronic message directly to</u>
another and attempts to extort money or other thing of value from any
person.

(2) The use of indecent, lewd, or obscene language or the making of
 a threat or lewd suggestion shall be prima facie evidence of intent to
 terrify, intimidate, threaten, harass, annoy, or offend.

(2) (3) The offense shall be deemed to have been committed either at
 the place where the call <u>or electronic message</u> was made or where it was
 received.

27 (3) (4) Intimidation by telephone call <u>or electronic message</u> is a
 28 Class III misdemeanor.

29 <u>(4) For purposes of this section:</u>

30 (a) Electronic communication device has the same meaning as in
 31 section 28-833; and

1	<u>(b) Electronic message means a text message, an electronic mail</u>
2	message, or any other communication which, in its ordinary and intended
3	use, is received by an electronic communication device.
