1 Section 1. Section 60-6,279, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2020, is amended to read:
- 3 60-6,279 (1) A person shall not operate a motorcycle or moped on any
- 4 highway in this state unless such person is wearing eye protection.
- 5 (2) Except as otherwise provided in subsections (3) and (4) of this
- 6 <u>section, a</u> A person shall not operate or be a passenger in an autocycle
- 7 described in subsection (2) of this section, on a motorcycle other than
- 8 an autocycle, or on a moped on any highway in this state unless such
- 9 person is wearing a protective helmet of the type and design manufactured
- 10 for use by operators of such vehicles and unless such helmet is secured
- 11 properly on <u>such person's</u> his or her head with a chin strap while the
- 12 vehicle is in motion. All such protective helmets shall be designed to
- 13 reduce injuries to the user resulting from head impacts and shall be
- 14 designed to protect the user by remaining on the user's head, deflecting
- 15 blows, resisting penetration, and spreading the force of impact. Each
- 16 such helmet shall consist of lining, padding, and chin strap and shall
- 17 meet or exceed the standards established in the United States Department
- 18 of Transportation's Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 218, 49
- 19 C.F.R. 571.218, for motorcycle helmets.
- 20 (3) A person who is at least twenty-one years of age and has been
- 21 <u>certified by the Motorcycle Safety Foundation basic motorcycle rider</u>
- 22 course or other substantially similar motorcycle rider course is exempt
- 23 from subdivision (2) of this section.
- 24 (4) For purposes of this section, eye protection means glasses that
- 25 <u>cover the orbital region of a person's face, a protective face shield</u>
- 26 <u>attached to a protective helmet, goggles, or a windshield on the</u>
- 27 <u>motorcycle or moped that protects the operator's and passenger's</u>
- 28 horizontal line of vision in all operating positions.
- 29 (2) This section applies to an autocycle that has a seating area
- 30 that is not completely enclosed.
