Section 1. Section 54-189, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 54-189 Satisfactory evidence of ownership consists of the 4 brands, tattoos, or marks on the livestock; point of origin of 5 livestock; the physical description of the livestock; and the б documentary evidence, such as bills of sale, brand clearance, 7 certificates of inspection, breed registration certificates, animal 8 health or testing certificates, recorded brand certificates, purchase sheets, scale tickets, disclaimers of interest, affidavits, court 9 orders, security agreements, powers of attorney, canceled checks, 10 11 bills of lading, or tags. ; and such other facts, statements, or 12 circumstances that taken in whole or in part cause an inspector to 13 believe that proof of ownership is established.
