- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to public assistance; to amend section
- 2 68-1006.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change the
- 3 personal needs allowance for aged, blind, and disabled persons; and
- 4 to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1           Section 1. Section 68-1006.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,  
2 is amended to read:

3           68-1006.01 The Department of Health and Human Services shall include  
4 in the standard of need for eligible aged, blind, and disabled persons at  
5 least one hundred sixty dollars per month for a personal needs allowance  
6 if such persons reside in an alternative living arrangement.

7           For purposes of this section, an alternative living arrangement  
8 shall include board and room, a boarding home, a certified adult family  
9 home, a licensed assisted-living facility, a licensed residential child-  
10 caring agency as defined in section 71-1926, a licensed center for the  
11 developmentally disabled, and a long-term care facility.

12          Sec. 2. Original section 68-1006.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of  
13 Nebraska, is repealed.
