1 Section 1. Section 68-1006.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,

- 2 is amended to read:
- 3 68-1006.01 The Department of Health and Human Services shall include
- 4 in the standard of need for eligible aged, blind, and disabled persons at
- 5 least <u>one hundred</u> sixty dollars per month for a personal needs allowance
- 6 if such persons reside in an alternative living arrangement.
- 7 For purposes of this section, an alternative living arrangement
- 8 shall include board and room, a boarding home, a certified adult family
- 9 home, a licensed assisted-living facility, a licensed residential child-
- 10 caring agency as defined in section 71-1926, a licensed center for the
- 11 developmentally disabled, and a long-term care facility.
- 12 Sec. 2. Original section 68-1006.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 13 Nebraska, is repealed.
