- 3 repeal the original section.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 70-407, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 70-407 For the purpose of Chapter 70 the following words shall be
4 construed to mean as follows:

5 (1) A kilowatt hour shall be deemed and considered to equal one 6 thousand watts, or the energy resulting from an activity of one kilowatt 7 continued for one hour, which equals about one and one-third horsepower 8 hours; <u>and</u>

9 (2) The word watt shall be construed to mean the practical unit of 10 electric power, activity, or rate of work equivalent to <u>one hundred seven</u> 11 107 ergs or one joule per second, or approximately one seven-hundred-12 forty-sixth of a horsepower.

Sec. 2. Original section 70-407, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is repealed.
