## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 629**

Introduced by Morfeld, 46. Read first time January 20, 2021 Committee:

- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to financial assistance related to COVID-19;
  to require a grant program to provide financial assistance to
  certain entities affected by event cancellations; and to declare an
  emergency.
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- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. (1) For purposes of this section:
2	(a) COVID-19 means the novel coronavirus identified as SARS-CoV-2,
3	the disease caused by the novel coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 or a virus
4	mutating therefrom, and the health conditions or threats associated with
5	the disease caused by the novel coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 or a virus
6	mutating therefrom;
7	(b) Department means the Department of Revenue; and
8	<u>(c) Eligible recipient means:</u>
9	(i) A municipality that has received a grant of assistance under the
10	Civic and Community Center Financing Act;
11	<u>(ii) A political subdivision as defined in section 13-3102 that is</u>
12	receiving state assistance pursuant to the Sports Arena Facility
13	Financing Assistance Act; and
14	<u>(iii) A county agricultural society organized under the County</u>
15	<u>Agricultural Society Act.</u>
16	<u>(2) The department shall establish a grant program to provide</u>
17	financial assistance to eligible recipients that have experienced a
18	negative financial impact as a result of the cancellation of events due
19	to COVID-19. The following types of events shall be considered for
20	purposes of this section:
21	<u>(a) Events that would have been held at an eligible facility as</u>
22	defined in section 13-2703 for which a grant of assistance was received
23	under the Civic and Community Center Financing Act;
24	(b) Events that would have been held at an eligible sports arena
25	facility as defined in section 13-3102 for which state assistance is
26	being provided pursuant to the Sports Arena Facility Financing Assistance
27	<u>Act; and</u>
28	<u>(c) Events that would have been held by a county agricultural</u>
29	<u>society.</u>
30	(3) An eligible recipient may apply to the department for a grant
31	under this section on a form prescribed by the department. The department

1	may approve an application, within the limits of available
2	appropriations, if the eligible recipient qualifies for financial
3	assistance under this section. The department shall determine the amount
4	of each grant based on the number of applications received, the available
5	appropriations, the negative financial impact experienced by the
6	applicant due to the cancellations described in this section, and such
7	<u>other criteria as the department may establish.</u>
8	(4) It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate eight million
9	dollars from the General Fund for fiscal year 2021-22 to the department
10	for purposes of carrying out this section.
