**LEGISLATIVE BILL 630**

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Security, Privacy, and Dissemination of
- 2 Criminal History Information Act; to amend section 29-3517, Reissue
- 3 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide duties for the Nebraska
- 4 State Patrol regarding criminal history record information checks;
- 5 and to repeal the original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 29-3517, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is  
2 amended to read:

3 29-3517 (1) Each criminal justice agency shall institute a process  
4 of data collection, entry, storage, and systematic audit of criminal  
5 history record information that will minimize the possibility of  
6 recording and storing inaccurate information. Any criminal justice agency  
7 which finds that it has reported inaccurate information of a material  
8 nature shall forthwith notify each criminal justice agency known to have  
9 received such information. Each criminal justice agency shall (a ~~1~~)  
10 maintain a listing of the individuals or agencies both in and outside of  
11 the state to which criminal history record information was released, a  
12 record of what information was released, and the date such information  
13 was released, (b ~~2~~) establish a delinquent disposition monitoring system,  
14 and (c ~~3~~) verify all record entries.

15 (2) Upon receipt of a request for a criminal history record, the  
16 Nebraska State Patrol shall undertake a search for criminal history  
17 record information relating to such applicant, including transmittal of  
18 the applicant's fingerprints to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for a  
19 national criminal history record information check. The criminal history  
20 record information check shall include information concerning the  
21 applicant from federal repositories of such information and repositories  
22 of such information in other states, if authorized by federal law. The  
23 Nebraska State Patrol shall issue a report to the employing agency that  
24 shall include the criminal history record information concerning the  
25 applicant.
