1 Section 1. Section 53-105, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 53-105 There is hereby created the Nebraska Liquor Control
- 4 Commission, consisting of five three members to be appointed by the
- 5 Governor, subject to confirmation by a majority of the members elected to
- 6 the Legislature, no more than two of whom shall be members of the same
- 7 political party, and no three two shall be citizens of the same
- 8 congressional district.
- 9 Sec. 2. Section 53-106, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 10 amended to read:
- 11 53-106 The Governor shall appoint five three members of the
- 12 commission, one of whom he shall designate as chairman. At the expiration
- of the next term, the Governor shall appoint three members, two of whom
- 14 shall be appointed for terms of six years and one of whom shall be
- 15 appointed for a term of four years. Except for the initial appointment of
- 16 such member appointed for four years, each member One member shall be
- 17 appointed every two years and shall hold office for a period of six
- 18 years. Any appointee may be removed by the Governor, after an opportunity
- 19 to be heard, for malfeasance, misfeasance or neglect in office. No person
- 20 shall be appointed to the commission, or continue to hold that office
- 21 after appointment, while holding any other office or position under the
- 22 laws of this state, any other state, or of the United States.
