- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to public records; to provide requirements and

- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. (1) This section applies to county records.

- 2 For purposes of this section, county records means public records
- 3 generated or maintained by a county.
- 4 (2) County records obtained pursuant to sections 84-712
- 5 to 84-712.09 shall not be resold for profit, made available for
- 6 resale, or otherwise used for trade or commercial purposes except
- 7 that:
- 8 (a) Publication or broadcast by the news media, a real
- 9 estate trade association, or multiple listing services operated by a
- 10 real estate trade association shall not constitute a resale or use
- 11 for trade or commercial purposes;
- 12 (b) Use of the information without resale by a licensed
- 13 professional in the course of practicing the professional's
- 14 profession shall not constitute use for trade or commercial purposes;
- 15 <u>and</u>
- 16 (c) Resale at cost by a real estate trade association or
- 17 multiple listing service operated by a real estate trade association
- 18 shall not constitute a resale or use for trade or commercial
- 19 purposes.
- 20 (3) The provisions of this section shall not apply to nor
- 21 impose any civil liability or penalty upon any public official,
- 22 public agency, or records custodian for granting access to or
- 23 providing copies of public records or information containing names
- 24 and addresses, in good faith compliance with sections 84-712 to
- 25 84-712.09, to a person who has made a written request for access to

- 2 (4) Each county shall provide, upon request of any
- 3 person, the following information:
- 4 (a) The principal address of the county courthouse and
- 5 <u>contact information for county officials;</u>
- 6 (b) The fees, if any, charged for access to or copies of
- 7 the county's records; and
- 8 (c) The procedures to be followed in requesting access to
- 9 and obtaining copies of county records.
