Section 1. Section 39-220, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 (1) The Department of Roads may at its discretion require 39-220 permits for advertising signs, displays, or devices which are placed or 4 5 allowed to exist along or upon any interstate or primary highway or at any point visible from the main-traveled way, except for signs located 6 7 within an area of fifty feet of any commercial or industrial building on the premises. Such permits shall be renewed biennially. Each sign shall 8 9 bear on the side facing the highway the permit number in a readily observable place for inspection purposes from the highway right-of-way. 10 The department is authorized to charge a fee to be not less than twenty-11 five cents or not to exceed fifteen dollars for each permit and renewal 12 13 permit for each individual sign. The department shall adopt and promulgate rules and regulations establishing, and from time to time 14 adjusting, the annual fees for the permits to cover the costs of 15 16 administering sections 39-212 to 39-226 and may by rule and regulation 17 provide exceptions from the payment of fees for signs advertising eleemosynary or nonprofit public service activities, signs designating 18 19 historical sites, and farm and ranch directional signs. The department may revoke the permit for noncompliance reasons and remove the sign if, 20 after thirty days' notification to the sign owner, the sign remains in 21 noncompliance. Printed sale bills not exceeding two hundred sixteen 22 square inches in size shall not require a permit if otherwise conforming. 23

24 (2) The department may require permits for the control of vegetation in the vicinity of advertising signs, displays, or devices placed 25 pursuant to subsection (1) of this section. A permit issued under this 26 subsection shall allow the cutting, trimming, or spraying of vegetation 27 under controlled conditions when such vegetation obstructs or obscures a 28 lawfully placed sign, display, or device. The permits shall be issued and 29 renewed in the same manner as provided in subsection (1) of this section. 30 31 The department shall adopt and promulgate rules and regulations for the
