A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to water resources; to amend section 46-288,

Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for

interbasin water transfers without a permit as

prescribed; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the

original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 46-288, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is amended to read:
- 3 46-288 For purposes of this section and section 46-289
- 4 and section 2 of this act, unless the context otherwise requires:
- 5 (1) Basin of origin shall mean the river basin in which
- 6 the point or proposed point of diversion of water is located;
- 7 (2) Beneficial use shall include, but not be limited to,
- 8 reasonable and efficient use of water for domestic, municipal,
- 9 agricultural, industrial, commercial, power production,
- 10 subirrigation, fish and wildlife, ground water recharge, interstate
- 11 compact, water quality maintenance, or recreational purposes. Nothing
- 12 in this subdivision shall be construed to affect the preferences for
- 13 use of surface water as provided in section 46-204;
- 14 (3) Interbasin transfer shall mean the diversion of water
- 15 in one river basin and the transportation of such water to another
- 16 river basin for storage or utilization for a beneficial use or during
- 17 times of flood as described in section 2 of this act; and
- 18 (4) River basin shall mean any of the following natural
- 19 hydrologic basins of the state as shown on maps located in the
- 20 Department of Natural Resources: (a) The White River and Hat Creek
- 21 basin; (b) the Niobrara River basin; (c) the Platte River basin,
- 22 including the North Platte and South Platte River basins, except that
- 23 for purposes of transfer between the North and South Platte River
- 24 basins each shall be considered a separate river basin; (d) the Loup
- 25 River basin; (e) the Elkhorn River basin; (f) the Republican River

1 basin; (g) the Little Blue River basin; (h) the Big Blue River basin;

- 2 (i) the Nemaha River basin; and (j) the Missouri tributaries basin.
- 3 Sec. 2. The Legislature finds that, for the best
- 4 management of Nebraska's water resources and for the protection of
- 5 public and private property, interbasin transfers from one river
- 6 basin to another river basin during times of flood should be allowed
- 7 without a permit issued by the department but only pursuant to an
- 8 agreement between the applicable districts.
- 9 The board of directors of a natural resources district or 10 an irrigation district in any river basin may establish a written 11 agreement with the board of directors of the natural resources 12 district or an irrigation district in an adjacent river basin to 13 allow interbasin transfers of surface water without a permit pursuant 14 to section 46-233 in order to mitigate public and private property damage when the river draining such river basin is at or above flood 15 16 stage. Such agreement shall be established in writing prior to the 17 occurrence of such transfer, shall specify that the river basin of destination shall be second in time and second in right to all 18 internal water resources projects within the basin of origin, and 20 shall include, but need not be limited to, any prearranged purchase 21 price of water, where such interbasin transfers can take place, under 22 what conditions such interbasin transfers can take place, and 23 requirements to notify the department and any affected rural water districts, public power and irrigation districts or other special 24 25 purpose districts in the basin of origin and the river basin of
