A BILL

- 1 FOR AN ACT relating to handguns; to amend section 69-2404, Reissue
- 2 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change the fee for
- 3 obtaining a handgun certificate; and to repeal the
- 4 original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 69-2404, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 69-2404 Any person desiring to purchase, lease, rent, or
4 receive transfer of a handgun shall apply with the chief of police or
5 sheriff of the applicant's place of residence for a certificate. The
6 application may be made in person or by mail. The application form
7 and certificate shall be made on forms approved by the Superintendent
8 of Law Enforcement and Public Safety. The application shall include
9 the applicant's full name, address, date of birth, and country of
10 citizenship. If the applicant is not a United States citizen, the
11 application shall include the applicant's place of birth and his or
12 her alien or admission number. If the application is made in person,
13 the applicant shall also present a current Nebraska motor vehicle
14 operator's license, state identification card, or military
15 identification card, or if the application is made by mail, the
16 application form shall describe the license or card used for
17 identification and be notarized by a notary public who has verified
18 the identification of the applicant through such a license or card.
19 An applicant shall receive a certificate if he or she is twenty-one
20 years of age or older and is not prohibited from purchasing or
21 possessing a handgun by 18 U.S.C. 922. A fee of ~~five~~ten dollars
22 shall be charged for each application for a certificate to cover the
23 cost of a criminal history record check.
