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1 Section 1. Section 81-3401, Revised Statutes Cumulative

- 2 Supplement, 2012, is amended to read:
- 3 81-3401 Sections 81-3401 to 81-3455 <u>and section 2 of this</u>
- 4 act shall be known and may be cited as the Engineers and Architects
- 5 Regulation Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. (1) An architect or professional engineer
- 7 licensed under the Engineers and Architects Regulation Act who
- 8 voluntarily and without compensation, other than expense
- 9 reimbursement, provides architectural, structural, electrical,
- 10 mechanical, or other design professional services related to a
- 11 <u>declared national, state, or local emergency caused by a natural</u>
- 12 <u>disaster</u>, terrorist attack, or other similar disaster or catastrophic
- 13 event, at the request of or with the approval of a national, state,
- 14 or local public official, law enforcement official, public safety
- 15 official, or building inspection official believed by the architect
- or professional engineer to be acting in an official capacity, shall
- 17 not be liable for any personal injury, wrongful death, property
- 18 damage, or other loss of any nature related to the architect's or
- 19 professional engineer's acts, errors, or omissions in the performance
- 20 of any architectural or engineering services for any structure,
- 21 building, facility, project, utility, equipment, machine, process,
- 22 piping, or other system, either publicly or privately owned.
- 23 (2) The immunity provided in this section shall apply
- 24 only to a voluntary architectural or engineering service that occurs
- 25 during the emergency or within ninety days following the date of the

- 2 (3) Nothing in this section shall provide immunity for
- 3 <u>willful, wanton, reckless, or intentional misconduct.</u>
- 4 (4) For purposes of this section:
- 5 (a) Building inspection official means any appointed or
- 6 elected federal, state, or local official with executive
- 7 responsibility to coordinate building inspection in the jurisdiction
- 8 <u>in which the emergency or event has occurred;</u>
- 9 (b) Law enforcement official means any appointed or
- 10 elected federal, state, or local official with executive
- 11 responsibility to coordinate law enforcement in the jurisdiction in
- which the emergency or event has occurred;
- (c) Public official means any federal, state, or locally
- 14 elected official with executive responsibility in the jurisdiction in
- which the emergency or event has occurred; and
- 16 (d) Public safety official means any appointed or elected
- 17 federal, state, or local official with executive responsibility to
- 18 coordinate public safety in the jurisdiction in which the emergency
- 19 or event has occurred.
