5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 7-105, Reissue Revised Statutes of
 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 7-105 It is the duty of an attorney and counselor: (1) To maintain the respect due to the courts of justice and to judicial 4 5 officers; (2) to counsel or maintain no other actions, proceedings or б defenses than those which appear to him legal and just, except the 7 defense of a person charged with a public offense; (3) to employ, for 8 the purpose of maintaining the cause confided to him, such means only as are consistent with the truth; (4) to maintain inviolate the 9 confidence, and, at any peril to himself, to preserve the secrets of 10 11 his clients; (5) to abstain from all offensive practices and to 12 advise no fact prejudicial to the honor or reputation of a party or 13 witness, unless required by the justice of the cause with which he is 14 charged; (6) not to encourage the commencement or continuance of an 15 action or proceeding from any motive of passion or interest; and (7) 16 not to drive a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcoholic liquor or of any drug. 17
