Committee:

- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to amend sections 79-530, 79-531, 1 2 79-532, and 79-533, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change 3 provisions relating to the involvement of parents and guardians in the education of their children; to require each public school 4 district to develop and adopt a policy relating to the rights of 5 each parent and guardian to access testing information and 6 7 curriculum and excuse their child from certain instruction or activities; to provide powers and duties to the Commissioner of 8 Education; and to repeal the original sections. 9
- 10 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 79-530, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 79-530 The Legislature finds and declares:
- 4 (1) That parental involvement of parents and guardians is a key
- 5 factor in the education of children;
- 6 (2) That parents or guardians need to be informed of the educational
- 7 practices affecting their children; and
- 8 (3) That public schools should foster and facilitate parents' and
- 9 <u>guardians' access to</u> <u>parental</u> information about and involvement in
- 10 educational practices affecting their children.
- 11 It is the intent of the Legislature, through the enactment of
- 12 sections 79-531 to 79-533 and sections 5, 6, and 7 of this act, to
- 13 strengthen the level of parental involvement and participation by parents
- 14 <u>and guardians</u> in the public school system of the state.
- 15 Sec. 2. Section 79-531, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 16 amended to read:
- 17 79-531 On or before July 1, <u>2024</u> 1995, each public school district
- in the state shall develop and adopt a policy stating how the district
- 19 will seek to involve parents and guardians in the education of their
- 20 <u>children</u> schools and the rights of each parent and guardian to: what
- 21 parents' rights shall be relating to access to the schools,
- 22 (1) Access testing information, and curriculum; and matters.
- 23 (2) Request that a child be excused from specific instruction or
- 24 <u>activities.</u>
- 25 Sec. 3. Section 79-532, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 26 amended to read:
- 79-532 (1) The policy required by section 79-531 shall include, but
- 28 need not be limited to, the following:
- 29 (a) (1) How the school district will provide access to parents or
- 30 <u>guardians</u> concerning textbooks; _T tests; <u>activities information; digital</u>
- 31 materials; websites or applications used for learning; training materials

1 for teachers, administrators, and staff; procedures for the review and

- 2 approval of training materials, learning materials, and activities; 7 and
- 3 other curriculum materials used in the school district;
- 4 (b) (2) How the school district will accommodate handle requests by
- 5 parents or guardians to attend and monitor courses, assemblies,
- 6 counseling sessions, and other instructional activities;
- 7 (c) (3) Under what circumstances parents or guardians may ask that
- 8 their children be excused from testing, classroom instruction, <u>learning</u>
- 9 <u>materials</u>, <u>activities</u>, <u>guest speaker events</u>, and other school experiences
- 10 the parents or guardians may find objectionable;
- 11 (d) (4) How the school district will provide access to records of
- 12 students;
- 13 (e) (5) What the school district's testing policy will be; and
- 14 (f) How the school district participates in surveys of students
- and the right of parents <u>or guardians</u> to remove their children from such
- 16 surveys.
- 17 (2) Nothing in this section shall be construed to require disclosure
- 18 of information in violation of the federal Family Educational Rights and
- 19 Privacy Act of 1974, as amended, 20 U.S.C. 1232g, or any federal
- 20 regulations and applicable guidelines adopted in accordance with such
- 21 <u>act, as such act, regulations, and guidelines existed on January 1, 2023.</u>
- 22 Sec. 4. Section 79-533, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 23 amended to read:
- 24 79-533 The policy required by section 79-531 shall be developed with
- 25 parental input from parents and guardians and shall be the subject of a
- 26 public hearing before the school board or board of education of the
- 27 school district before adoption by the board. The policy shall be
- 28 reviewed annually and either altered and adopted as altered or reaffirmed
- 29 by the board following a public hearing. Any public hearing under this
- 30 section shall include a reasonable opportunity for public comments.
- 31 Sec. 5. By August 1, 2024, each school district shall make the

- 1 policy required by section 79-531 accessible on the school district's
- 2 <u>public website</u>. The policy shall be accessible by a prominently displayed
- 3 link on such website. If the policy is altered, the new version of the
- 4 policy shall be made accessible within a reasonable time thereafter.
- 5 Sec. 6. To the extent practicable, each public school district
- 6 shall make a reasonable effort to make any learning materials, including
- 7 original materials, available for inspection by a parent or guardian upon
- 8 <u>request.</u>
- 9 Sec. 7. If the Commissioner of Education determines that any school
- 10 <u>district has intentionally refused, in a material manner, to comply with</u>
- 11 sections 79-531 to 79-533 and sections 5 and 6 of this act, the
- 12 commissioner shall notify the school district of the noncompliance and
- 13 <u>allow the school district a reasonable time to comply. If the</u>
- 14 commissioner determines, after such time has elapsed, that the school
- 15 district is not in compliance and has not made a good faith attempt to
- 16 comply, the commissioner shall take appropriate remedial action within
- 17 the commissioner's authority, up to and including qualifying such
- 18 <u>noncompliance as a violation of the rules and regulations for the</u>
- 19 accreditation of schools.
- 20 Sec. 8. Original sections 79-530, 79-531, 79-532, and 79-533,
- 21 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
