6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 49-1401, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 2 amended to read: 49-1401 Sections 49-1401 to 49-14,142 and section 2 of this act 3 4 shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Political Accountability 5 and Disclosure Act. Sec. 2. No person shall make one or more contributions to a 6 7 candidate committee totaling more than five thousand dollars during an election period. A candidate committee shall refund any contribution from 8 9 a person which exceeds a total of five thousand dollars received during

10 an election period from such person within ten days after receipt and report such contribution on subsequent campaign statements disclosing the 11 name and address of the contributor, the amount received, the date of 12 receipt, and the date returned. This section does not apply to a 13 candidate's own personal funds contributed to that candidate's committee. 14 For purposes of this section, election period means the calendar year of 15 the election. 16 17 Sec. 3.
