5	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 53-194.03, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
 is amended to read:

53-194.03 (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to transport,
import, bring, ship, or cause to be transported, imported, brought, or
shipped into the State of Nebraska for the personal use of the possessor,
his or her family, or guests a quantity of alcoholic liquor in excess of
<u>one hundred eight nine liters in any one calendar year month.</u>

8 (2) Alcoholic liquor transported, imported, brought, or shipped into 9 the State of Nebraska in violation of this section shall be seized by the 10 commission and disposed of in the manner provided for contraband. Any 11 person violating this section shall be guilty of a Class IV misdemeanor.
