Section 1. Section 60-3,156, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 1

- 2 2018, is amended to read:
- 60-3,156 In addition to the registration fees for motor vehicles and 3
- trailers, the county treasurer or his or her agent shall collect: 4
- (1) Two dollars for each certificate issued and shall remit two 5
- dollars of each additional fee collected to the State Treasurer for 6
- 7 credit to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund;
- (2) Fifty cents for each certificate issued and shall remit the fee 8
- to the State Treasurer for credit to the Nebraska Emergency Medical 9
- 10 System Operations Fund; and
- (3) One dollar and fifty cents for each certificate issued and shall 11
- remit the fee to the State Treasurer for credit to the State Recreation 12
- Road Fund; and -13
- (4) Fifty cents for each certificate issued and shall remit the fee 14
- to the State Treasurer for credit to the University of Nebraska Medical 15
- Center Simulation in Motion-Nebraska Fund. 16
- 17 Sec. 2. There is hereby created the University of Nebraska Medical
- Center Simulation in Motion-Nebraska Fund. The fund may receive gifts, 18
- bequests, grants, fees, or other contributions or donations from public 19
- or private entities. The fund shall be used to carry out the simulation 20
- 21 in motion program of the University of Nebraska Medical Center, including
- 22 training first responders, out-of-hospital emergency care providers, and
- critical-access-hospital staff in rural areas. Any money in the fund not 23
- 24 used to defray the annual operating expenses of the simulation in motion
- 25 program shall be used to establish a subaccount to fund expenses related
- to the depreciation of the equipment used in the simulation in motion 26
- program. Any money in the fund available for investment shall be invested 27
- by the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital 28
- Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act. 29
- Sec. 3. This act becomes operative on August 1, 2020. 30
