## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 763**

- 3 to repeal the original section.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 37-729, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 37-729 For purposes of sections 37-729 to 37-736:

4 (1) Land includes roads, water, watercourses, private ways, private
5 <u>airstrips or runways, and buildings, structures, and machinery or</u>
6 equipment thereon when attached to the realty;

7 (2) Owner includes tenant, lessee, occupant, or person in control of8 the premises;

9 (3) Recreational purposes includes, but is not limited to, any one 10 or any combination of the following: Hunting, fishing, swimming, boating, 11 camping, picnicking, hiking, pleasure driving, nature study, waterskiing, 12 winter sports, <u>noncommercial aviation activities,</u> and visiting, viewing, 13 or enjoying historical, archaeological, scenic, or scientific sites, or 14 otherwise using land for purposes of the user; and

(4) Charge means the amount of money asked in return for aninvitation to enter or go upon the land.

Sec. 2. Original section 37-729, Reissue Revised Statutes ofNebraska, is repealed.
