5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1	Section 1. There is hereby appropriated \$1,800,000 from					
2	the General Fund for FY2014-15, to the Board of Regents of the					
3	<u>University of Nebraska, for Program 781, for pediatric cancer</u>					
4	research at the University of Nebraska Medical Center. The Board of					
5	Regents shall report how such funds were spent to the Appropriations					
6	Committee of the Legislature on or before December 31, 2014. The					
7	report shall be submitted electronically.					
8	Sec. 2. Section 84-612, Revised Statutes Supplement,					
9	2013, is amended to read:					
10	84-612 (1) There is hereby created within the state					
11	treasury a fund known as the Cash Reserve Fund which shall be under					
12	the direction of the State Treasurer. The fund shall only be used					
13	pursuant to this section.					
14	(2) The State Treasurer shall transfer funds from the					
15	Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund upon certification by the					
16	Director of Administrative Services that the current cash balance in					
17	the General Fund is inadequate to meet current obligations. Such					
18	certification shall include the dollar amount to be transferred. Any					
19	transfers made pursuant to this subsection shall be reversed upon					
20	notification by the Director of Administrative Services that					
21	sufficient funds are available.					
22	(3) In addition to receiving transfers from other funds,					
23	the Cash Reserve Fund shall receive federal funds received by the					
24	State of Nebraska for undesignated general government purposes,					

25 federal revenue sharing, or general fiscal relief of the state.

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1 (4) On July 7, 2009, the State Treasurer shall transfer 2 five million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Roads 3 Operations Cash Fund. The Department of Roads shall use such funds to 4 provide the required state match for federal funding made available 5 to the state through congressional earmarks.

6 (5) The State Treasurer shall transfer a total of thirty-7 seven million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund 8 on or before June 30, 2012, on such dates and in such amounts as 9 directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the 10 Department of Administrative Services.

(6) The State Treasurer shall transfer a total of sixtyeight million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund on or before June 30, 2013, on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services.

(7) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget 16 17 administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services, shall transfer not to exceed twelve million 18 dollars in total between July 1, 2011, and November 30, 2012, from 19 20 the Cash Reserve Fund to the Ethanol Production Incentive Cash Fund, 21 for ethanol production incentive credits, on such dates and in such amounts as certified by the Tax Commissioner. 22

(8) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget
administrator of the budget division of the Department of
Administrative Services, shall transfer an amount equal to the total

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1 amount transferred pursuant to subsection (7) of this section from 2 the Ethanol Production Incentive Cash Fund to the Cash Reserve Fund 3 in such amounts as certified by the Tax Commissioner on or before 4 November 30, 2012.

5 (9) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget 6 administrator of the budget division of the Department of 7 Administrative Services, shall transfer eighty million dollars from 8 the Cash Reserve Fund to the Nebraska Capital Construction Fund on or 9 before August 15, 2012.

10 (10) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget 11 administrator of the budget division of the Department of 12 Administrative Services, shall transfer one million dollars from the 13 Cash Reserve Fund to the Affordable Housing Trust Fund on or before 14 August 15, 2012.

15 (11) The State Treasurer shall transfer ten million 16 dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund on or before 17 June 30, 2013, on such date as directed by the budget administrator 18 of the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services.

19 (12) The State Treasurer, at the direction of the budget 20 administrator of the budget division of the Department of 21 Administrative Services, shall transfer not to exceed forty-three 22 million fifteen thousand four hundred fifty-nine dollars in total 23 from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Nebraska Capital Construction Fund 24 between July 1, 2013, and June 30, 2017.

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(13) The State Treasurer shall transfer one million eight

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1	hundred thousand dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the General
2	Fund on or before July 1, 2014, on such dates and in such amounts as
3	directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the
4	Department of Administrative Services.
